Timing: Automated start system and two buttons for the primary system with watch

back up. Goal is 2 timers per lane (see timing assignments). Bring a shade to

cover your lane.

Relay Entries: Each team may enter 1 relay per relay event, up to 8 names listed per relay.

Indiv. Entries: Each school may enter 4 swimmers and divers per event with exception to 6

swimmers in the 50 free and 5 swimmers in the 100 Free. An individual may be entered in a maximum of two individual events and three relays but no more than 4 events total. An individual entered in more than 2 individual events will be removed from their last one(s). The 500 Freestyle will be positive check in

due by 8:15 AM.

Entry Instructions: The first 4 additional teams to request entry to this invite will be sent the meet

information. Entries may be completed via Hy-Tek electronic entry or via an email on an excel spreadsheet. Please place girls and boys on separate entry forms if by excel. Entries are requested to be the swimmer's best SCY time. Entries submitted SCM will be converted by the computer. Entries are due by Wednesday, October 16, 2019, at 11:00 PM to Meet Director Samantha Kramer

Meet Information: Heat sheets will be available for purchase upon entry into the event for \$5 per

sheet. 2 copies of the heat sheets will be provided for each team. Results will be

generated via the computer and posted during breaks and when possible.
