Horizon Swim and Dive Code of Conduct

As an authorized representative of Horizon High School Swim and Dive, I will comply with the following guidelines:

- 1. Offer congratulations to opponents, win or lose, and cheer on their teammates.
- 2. Wear the designated team suit, cap, and other clothing as prescribed by the coaches.
- 3. Follow the directions of the coaching staff during practice, meets, and other team activities.
- 4. Not possess, sell, or use alcohol, tobacco, or any non-prescribed drugs. This behavior is not tolerated. This includes recreational drugs such as Hookah and Vape.
- 5. Not remove or take any article that does not belong to them, such as clothing, jewelry, or money.
- 6. Respect the property of any facility the team may visit or use. No swimmer shall tamper with or cause damage to any such facility.
- 7. Display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, and administrators, fellow competitors, parents, and the public.
- 8. Promote positive team spirit and morale, which includes being humble in victory and courageous in defeat. Deal justly, kindly, impartially, and intelligently with all fellow team members.

(Pursuing Victory with Honor)

- 9. Refrain from all illegal or inappropriate behaviors that would detract from a positive image of the team or be detrimental to its performance objectives.
- 10. Be 100% financially responsible for any damage to any part of their buses, facilities, etc when traveling with the team.
- 11. Team members and staff will attend all team functions including meetings, warm-ups, practices, competitions, meals, etc., unless otherwise excused or instructed by the coach of record.
- 12. Team members and staff will refrain from any illegal or inappropriate behavior that would detract from a positive image of Horizon High School Swim and Dive or be detrimental to its performance objectives.
- 13. Any additional guidelines for the team will be established as needed by the coach of record. Students are responsible for all guidelines as established by the student handbook for both the district and the school.
- 14. Prompt pick up upon the conclusion of practices or return from meets.
- 15. All guidelines as established in any school or district Code of Conduct/Handbook

Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct may result in, but not necessarily be limited to:

- 1. Swimmer/Diver not allowed participating in some or all team activities.
- 2. Swimmer/Diver dismissed from one or more events, or all events of competition
- 3. Swimmer/Diver immediately being sent home at their expense
- 4. Swimmer/Diver being temporarily or permanently dismissed from the team.
- 5. Financial penalties (return from meet, lost entries, destruction of property fines etc.)

The coach in charge, along with the Head Coach will make the final decision in matters of discipline or dismissal based on the degree of violation of the above code.

***Swimmers should not leave any personal items in the locker room at Roadrunner Pool. Keep your belongings with you at all times. The facility and its staff ARE NOT responsible for lost or stolen items.

Do not leave any item on the bus to or from practice or swim meets as it may not be the same bus each time we get on!!
